Flute Boot Camp and Camp Coda Master Class are summer day camps led by outstanding flutists/teachers: Carla Wilson, retired Piccolo/Third Flute, Oregon Symphony/Instructor of Flute-University of Portland; Sydney Carlson, Professor of Flute, Portland State University, Portland Opera Orchestra; and Denise Westby, Instructor of Flute, Linfield College. Campers are required to bring their instrument(s) in good working order (have them checked out before camp), their music/materials, and a music stand to each day of camp. They also agree to practice each night to prepare for the next day's session.

Tuition:
___\$360 Flute Boot Camp- includes ensemble music, instructional materials, lunch daily, camp t-shirt, and non-refundable \$15 registration fee.

A deposit of \$125 plus the \$15 registration fee, along with this form will hold a place for your camper. The remaining tuition must be received no later than June 1. There is a \$25 late fee if payments are received after June 1. If the minimum number of students needed is not reached, your deposit and registration fee will be immediately returned. Early registration is highly recommended. Some financial aid *may* be available based on financial need. To apply, include a letter from your child's school documenting their eligibility for free or reduced lunch. You will be contacted regarding your request.
